If your application is found to be invalid or incomplete after the filing deadline has passed, you cannot re-file. Therefore, it is suggested that you file your application at least one week before this deadline.)
2/21	5:00 p.m. Deadline for write-in candidates to declare candidacy in the election.
2/22	First day that an election may be cancelled if each candidate is unopposed.
2/23	2:00 p.m. Drawing to determine the order of names on the ballot will be held in the City Secretary's office. (The candidates or their representatives are encouraged (but not required) to be present for the drawing.)
2/24	5:00 p.m. Last day for a candidate to withdraw (Must receive in writing, see pp. 281-282)
4/6	First report of campaign contributions and expenditures due by 5:00 p.m. in the City Secretary's office. (Required of opposed candidates and specific-purpose committees supporting or opposing opposed candidates.) Last day a person may register to vote in the May 6, 2017 General Election.

Officeholders who file with a local filing authority (e.g., City Secretary), do not have a campaign treasurer appointment on file (other than themselves), and do not accept more than \$500 in officeholder contributions or make more than \$500 in officeholder expenditures during the period covered by the report do not have to file.)
